Reform say they back working people - but their own words tell a different story. When it mattered most, they voted against the Employment Rights Bill and turned their backs on working people.

Labour's Employment Rights Bill is the first step in making the New Deal for Working People a reality. It will raise wages and strengthen workplace protections. It's the biggest boost to workers' rights in decades.

Reform claim they stand for up working people. But the truth is their MPs turned their backs on workers when they sided with bad bosses, and voted to block the Employment Rights Bill.

- Ending Fire and Rehire

- Flexible working and family-friendly rights
- A new enforcement agency to crack down on bad employers
- More say at work so unions can raise pay and improve conditions
